General terms

We invite submissions on the following topics:

- Conceptions of the cosmos
- Testing cosmological models
- Anthropics and the multiverse
- Humanity in the cosmos
- Scope of cosmological theories and data
- Future studies
- Cosmos and culture
- Nature and civilization
- Cosmos and history

Terms for manuscripts submission:

- By July 1 each year;
- By November 1 each year

Article manuscripts should include:

1. A file with information about each author—name, surname, and patronymic; position, workplace; academic rank, scientific degree; contact details; ORCID ID; and a brief description of each author's scientific interests and accomplishments.
2. The manuscript formatted according to the APA Style.

Article Structure

Follow APA Style and layout guidelines (see the relevant links).

Final Provisions

- It is not acceptable to submit materials that do not comply with the rules established by the publisher, or violate any requirements related to publication parameters.
- Do not submit texts obtained using automatic translation programs or AI-generated texts.
- Do not submit unprepared or incomplete materials.
- Do not delay in submitting the materials provided by the publisher for correction.
